## In Case of an Emergency

1. Remain Calm.
2. Exit your unit or common area to the nearest stairwell.
3. Exit out of the stairwell to a garage.
4. Each garage has an exit to the building's exterior. Please continue exiting until you are outside of the building.

\*If the onsite staff is with fire, police, or emergency personnel please do not attempt to follow them or interrupt with questions. This is very important to the safety of our building and to all residents. Onsite staff will notify residents when it is safe to return to their homes, or answer questions when the building has been secured and cleared of danger.\*



## SAFETY AND EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

In an effort to reduce the amount of criminal activity around Belltown Court, we would like to provide you with a reference guide to city officials and departments responsible for managing these concerns. Reports have increased over the

last few months regarding bar noise, transient loitering, and other criminal offenses. As a building, we can take a stand against these problems. There are several ways to get involved, but it will take your participation. In addition, we would like all of our residents
